- **Berkshire Encyclopedia of World History** - Reference eBook covering essential world history themes and patterns such as art, disease, government, religion, science, and war and peace.
- **Child Development** - Reference eBook from Macmillan Psychology Reference series covering issues related to human development from conception through adolescence.
- **Company Profiles for Students** - Reference eBook that covers approximately 280 of the prominent companies most studied by students; includes company logos, illustrations and ticker symbols, current market share, new products, and more.
- **Computer Sciences** - Reference eBook covering computer science history, concepts, contributors in the field, and impact on society.
- **Countries and Their Cultures** - Reference eBook on cultures and countries, including demographic, historical, cultural, economic, religious, and political information.
- **Encyclopedia of Business and Finance** - Reference eBook of business information, including accounting, economics, finance, information systems law, management, and marketing.
