If you have previously attended a Field Training Officers (FTO) Course you are not eligible to attend this training.

This course is being co-sponsored with the Ocean City Police Department. This course will cover continuing training for entrance-level law enforcement personnel, which may be appropriately addressed by field training officers. Emphasis will be placed on observation of actual fieldwork, reporting and evaluating performance activity, counseling and motivation of the entrance-level law enforcement officer.

Upon completion of this course, the student should be able to:

- Identify a training need within their agency and prepare an appropriate method of addressing the need.
- 2. Identify and explain methods of gathering performance data.
- 3. List and define the basic objectives of performance appraisal systems.
- 4. Identify and explain the elements of counseling.
- 5. Define the basic objectives of a field-training officer that should include productivity, efficiency, work quality and motivation of employees.

This course is designed to meet requirements as mandated by the Maryland Police Training Commission and to meet the annual in-service requirements.

Class Size: Seating limited.

Attendance: You must attend the entire course to receive in-service credit.

Dress Code:
