The Law Enforcement Officer or Operator will gain knowledge and skills necessary to prevent the loss of their life or the life of another while in an emergency or tactical environment. The skills will address treating life threatening injuries in an austere environment with limited equipment, lack of medially trained personnel and prolonged time to evacuation.

Given simulated tactical environment, the student will be able to apply basic first responder medical skills within the principles of Tactical Emergency Casualty Care and save preventable deaths without causing further casualties to team members.

#### Upon completion of this course, the student should be able to:

- 1. Define a medical threat assessment, to include a medial plan for a tactical operation;
- 2. Demonstrate techniques to control life-threatening bleeding during Care Under Fire;
- 3. Perform techniques to treat life threatening and non-life threatening injuries during Tactical Field Care:
- 4. Demonstrate lifting, moving and extricating victims from a tactical or hostile environment during Tactical Evacuation Care.

This course is designed to meet requirements as mandated by the Maryland Police Training Commission and to meet the annual in-service requirements.

Class Size:

Seating limited.

Attendance:

You must attend the entire course to receive in-service credit.

### **Dress Code:**

In order to maintain a professional appearance, all in-service officers/staff must follow the prescribed dress code to be admitted to any training held at the Academy.
